

THE COMMUNITY OF SUNNINGHILL CELEBRATED SPRING TOGETHER IN THE SUNNINGHILL GARDENS PARK

With the assistance of the Sunninghill Islamic Jamaat we installed benches and planted rose gardens in the Kilindini Park and thanks to the Koutakis family erected more playground equipment for our children.

In addition to the above we saw the birth of the **Rockmead Heritage Park** in Rutherford Road Sunninghill Estates. With the assistance of Sunninghill Community a group of residents petitioned the Council to preserve a small rocky portion where important bushman artefacts had been discovered and which contained several irreplaceable indigenous trees. The site which was overgrown has since been cleared and the intention is to appropriately landscape secure it and install pathways which would take visitors through the reserve leading to a small boma, housing benches and educational displays.
