Sunninghill Village Skate Park Project

Kilindini Park, Sunninghill



- Kilindini Park is situated on the corner of Nanyuki Road and Kilindini Street close to Sunninghill Hospital in Sunninghill.
- The proposed Sunninghill Village Skate Park project is an initiative of the Sunninghill Community Ratepayers Association, Sunninghill Village Shopping Center (SVS) along with other community organizations and business partners and of course under the auspicious of Johannesburg Parks and City Council. It would be the first of its kind of “Public Skateboard Park “ in Johannesburg. SVS has approached Sunninghill Community with the generous donation of a Million Rand worth of Skateboarding infrastructure and equipment. Sunninghill Community have accepted the donation.
- There has been some positive response from local business and organizations for sponsorships.

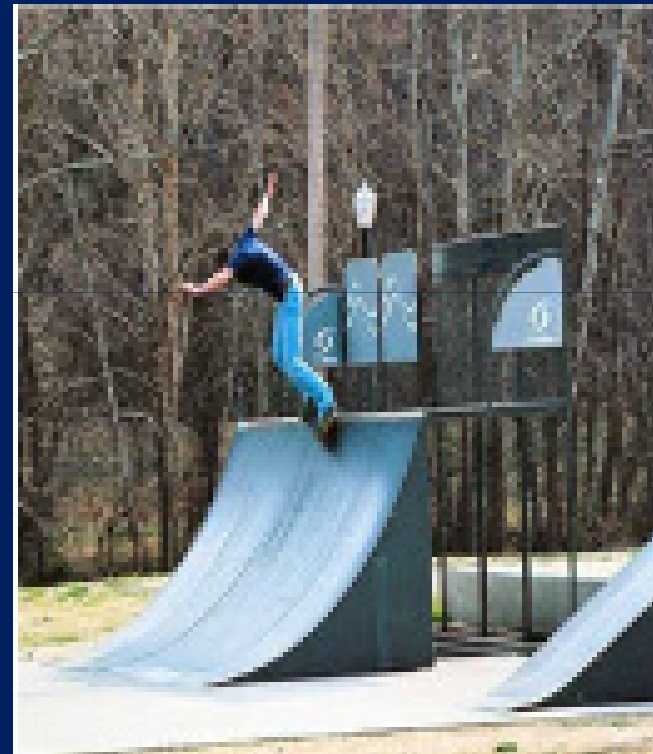


Kilindini Park Proposed Layout



Overview

- The Skateboard park would require 700 m² to erect the plinth and infra-structure and a total area required with spectator stands and palisade fencing would be approximately 1500 m².
- To build the foundation, Sunninghill Community have acquired quotations from building contractors, and initial indication of the cost is around R 285,000.00
- The transfer of the skateboard infra-structure and equipment will cost also around R80,000.00, sponsorship for this has been secured.
- Erecting of the palisade fencing and spectator stands, Sunninghill Community is contacting a City Parks contractor to supply the quotations
- If required a EIA will be carried out.



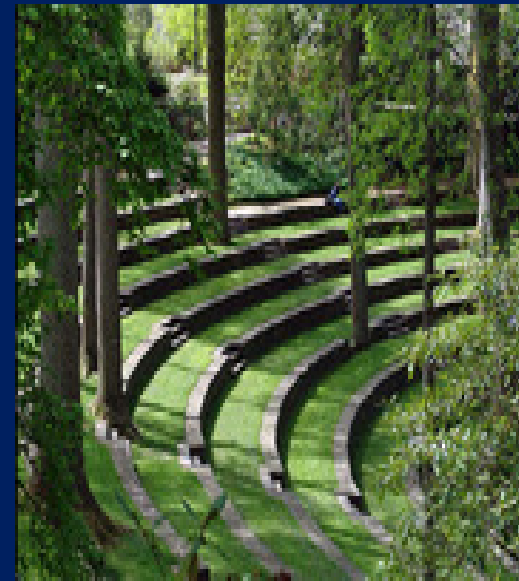
Kilindini Park

- **Skate Park (palisade fencing to be placed around the 1500 m² area, 700 m² cement slab to be put down, a shade shelter to be erected, managers (with first aid certificates) to be employed and to lock up the park at the end of every day)**
- **Paved pedestrian pathways throughout the park**
- **Soil erosion repairing – grass embankments to be designed with seating arrangements**
- **Sense garden**
- **Kilindini park equipment to be re-arranged and upgraded**
- **Vehicle parking area**
- **Cricket nets**
- **Basket ball court**

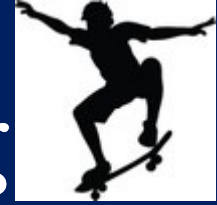


Proposed concepts for Kilindini
