REZONING FOR PLACE OF PUBLIC WORSHIP (MOSQUE), PLACE OF INSTRUCTION (MADRESSA) AND PARKING AREA IN SUNNINGHILL

We have received copies of two application for rezoning (which are linked) that have been submitted to Council. These applications, appeared in the Government Gazette today 19th September 2018 and are displayed on the properties in question.

The rezoning of the 2 erven are to permit a place of public worship (Mosque) and place of instruction (Madressa) and the establishment of a parking area on Erf 162 associated with Erf 160 Sunninghill (situated at 36 Edison Crescent, 2 and 6 Tesla Crescent).

These applications for rezoning with all the relevant documents and architects impression and site plan are available for viewing in the Sunninghill Community Office, first floor (above the ATM), Sunninghill Village Shopping centre, cnr Edison and Maxwell Drive. Our office is open Mon to Frid from 08h00 to 13h00. You can also view these documents by following the links below on your web browser.

It is important to note that rezoning allows for public participation, which is your right. If you have no problem with these rezoning applications you simply ignore. If however you do object please download the form provided, complete and email to:
